

Emory at Grady Community Impact Award

The Emory at Grady Community Award has been established by the Emory at Grady Award Committee to recognize faculty whose work has elevated our community at the level of our school, hospital system, or the city and counties that we serve. The award may honor an individual or team for various forms of engagement that have made a significant impact on the community that Grady serves or the members of Grady Health Care. This can include volunteer service, program development, or community organizing. Honorees should demonstrate a commitment to partnering with others to generate a sustainable impact on community needs.

Deadline: Nominations will be accepted through **August 12, 2022**.

Eligibility: All current Emory faculty with at least 50% of their clinical, teaching, or research effort on the Grady campus. Eligible nominees have exhibited extraordinary efforts in community impact for patients, families, communities, and trainees at the local, regional, and/or national level.

Examples include but are not limited to:

- Creation of novel programs to mentor underrepresented identities
- Development and implementation of an educational series on diversity, equity, and inclusion in the Grady community
- Novel programs or projects in care delivery, connectivity, and health promotion
- Engagement with community partners to address health disparities
- Innovative community outreach
- Sustained dedication to the Grady community

Nominations: Faculty must be nominated by a faculty, staff, or a trainee of Emory University. The nomination should consist of a concise narrative (1000 words or less) describing the nominee's advocacy and the impact these actions have had.

Submission: Must be submitted using the [Online Nomination Form](#) and include the following:

- Nominating letter (1000 words or less)
- Nominee's current Curriculum Vitae

Decision: Will be made by a subcommittee of the Emory at Grady Faculty Development Committee.

Award: The recipient of the Emory at Grady Community Impact Award will be announced and honored during the annual School of Medicine Celebration of Faculty Excellence and at the annual Emory at Grady Awards reception.
