

USE OF EUSOM BUILDING FOR ESSENTIAL IN-PERSON EDUCATION

Guidelines:

- Use of SOM building will be for educational activities that require in-person attendance; such activities include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - Small group discussions
 - Instruction and assessment of physical examination skills
 - Laboratory sessions
- Use of SOM building for educational activities that will be done remotely (i.e. lectures), will be offered to students who voluntarily would like to attend in-person
 - Students can voluntarily attend such a session (but total number of students allowed will be based on the maximum COVID capacity for the specific room/ space) –this will be accomplished by a sign-up system +/- a lottery if needed
- Each educational activity will limit the total number of participants (faculty, students, and/or residents) to the maximum capacity of that room, as determined by EHSO guidelines
- Masks will be required of students and faculty entering the SOM building; students and faculty must wear masks the entire time they are in the building, except for faculty who have a private office while in that office alone.
- Students/faculty will be asked to use hand sanitizer upon entering and before exiting any classroom/laboratory that is used
- Students/faculty will be asked to wipe down their space (computer, desk/table, etc.) inside the classroom/laboratory upon entering and before exiting the classroom/laboratory that is used (disinfectant wipes to be provided in each classroom/laboratory)
- Students/faculty will not be allowed to eat or drink during educational activities in the SOM building; any/all eating or drinking needs to be done outside of the building
- Students/faculty will be required to maintain social distancing practices inside the SOM building (remaining 6 feet apart)
- Students/faculty will be required to self-screen for COVID symptoms using the EHC Symptom Checker prior to entering the SOM building; any student/faculty who has symptoms suggestive of COVID-19 should follow the Symptom Checker advice and will not be allowed to enter the SOM building
- The SOM personnel will perform random temperature screenings of students/faculty entering the SOM building; anyone with a temperature of ≥ 100.4 degrees F (38 degrees C) will not be allowed to enter the building and students will be referred to Student Health
- Students/faculty will be encouraged to use the stairs whenever physically possible
- Only one individual is allowed to ride on an elevator at a time
- Each SOM space will have (and maintain) a designated entrance to and exit from the building for students/faculty to use (e.g. students/faculty scheduled to be in SOM 110 will enter via the left front door entrance and exit via the door outside of 110 towards WHSCAB)

- Entrances and exits will be assigned to most effectively reduce the number of individuals interacting with each other in and around the SOM building and to reduce the number of students/faculty at any one time and location waiting to enter the building
- Room entrance/exit assignments are below
- In addition, each SOM educational space will have (and maintain) a designated bathroom for students/faculty to use while in that space for an educational activity (e.g. students/faculty scheduled to be in SOM 110 will use the bathroom on the A wing outside of 153A)
 - Bathroom designation for each SOM space below
- Start and end times of events will be staggered (10-15 minutes) to most effectively reduce the number of individuals interacting with each other at time of entry into and while in the SOM building
- Students may not arrive any earlier than 10 minutes before a scheduled session and must leave promptly after the end of a session
- Students/faculty will be prohibited from congregating inside or outside of the SOM building; use of student lockers and common areas will be prohibited
- All students/faculty will be educated about the new procedures and expectations prior to return to the SOM building
