Finding Funding for Research and Training

1. Grants.gov

- Resource for ALL federal funding
- Subscribe to email alerts
- Manage subscriptions <http://www.grants.gov/web/grants/manage-subscriptions.html>

2. NIH-specific tools

- **NIH Office of Extramural Research** <http://grants.nih.gov/grants/oer.htm>
 - **About Grants** – great resource for all information about NIH grant applications, all levels, all funders
 - **Finding Funding** – searchable database of active and archived funding opportunities from many government funders, not just NIH (easier to search than grants.gov but not as inclusive)
- Examine individual **NIH Institute / Center websites** to find funding for research and training opportunities from that funder, learn their priorities
 - Sign up for e-Newsletters
- **Fogarty International Center's** searchable funding database to locate international funding opportunities - Funding Opportunities <http://www.fic.nih.gov/Funding/Pages/default.aspx>
- **NIH RePORTER** tool to review others' research abstracts and see which NIH I/C funds what areas of research and training projectreporter.nih.gov/reporter.cfm
 - Allows you to “search a repository of NIH-funded research projects and access publications and patents resulting from that funding”.
 - Examine published abstracts of funded NIH research at RePORTER to see how others in your field describe their Specific Aims – these are typically repeated in the Abstract, which can be searched here.

3. Grant Forward www.grantforward.com (need net id to use this)

- Search for grant opportunities, save and share your query, and sign up for email alerts
- Search on all kinds of key words: Cancer, Diabetes, Small grants, Bridge funding, Disease association clinical funding opportunities, Travel and conference awards/competitions

4. Foundation Directory Online - www.healthlibrary.emory.edu/ *Databases, Foundation Directory* (need net id to use this)

- Searches on broad biomedical search terms, diseases, or any “text” word
- To search for which foundations fund your ideas/criteria “Search Grantmakers” (not “Search Grants”)
- Very rich database for private foundation funding

5. **Trialect** www.trialect.com Global platform for health professionals; access to grants, fellowships, courses, observerships, etc.

6. **Disease and Professional Association** websites and listserves – look for Funding and Career Development tabs, sign up for newsletters and email alerts for funding opportunities

7. **Google** – Intuitive ‘no rules’ searching: Type in just what you are thinking -

- ***Who funds gynecological epidemiology research***
- Reproductive epidemiology grants fellowships
- Career Development Award pulmonary
- Travel scholarships epidemiology
- Young Investigator HIV
