<p>Rolling Reviewing and Deadlines</p>	<p>We utilize a rolling reviewing process. We will close the application to new submissions when we reach capacity, which may occur on or BEFORE Dec. 1, 2025. We will review competitive, complete, and verified applications in order they are received and work to fill our interview dates and our class. We encourage candidates to submit their complete application and Emory supporting documents as early in the cycle as possible.</p>

Information Sessions We will schedule Open House sessions during the 2025-2026 cycle to highlight features that make the Emory University AA Program unique, share any added details regarding prerequisites, curriculum updates and clinical opportunities; and address questions about the application process. IMPORTANT NOTES:

Due to the high volume of applications that we receive each year, we strongly recommend that you submit your application (CASAA, GRE/MCAT and Emory AA supplemental documents) EARLY. Don't wait until the deadline.

Early submission does not guarantee an interview, but it can place your competitive application in review earlier. Deadline extensions will not be granted for late, incomplete applications or those that are not competitive.

Applicants are welcome to be in progress with required prerequisite courses and academic programs during the application cycle. Final decisions are contingent on the successful outcomes of all outlined requirements.

Evaluate Your Competitiveness We anticipate receiving over five hundred applications for a class of up to 40 students, meaning your application must stand out. We carefully review each applicant in their entirety, considering academic achievements, letters of recommendation, community involvement, leadership roles, clinical and patient care exposure, and extracurricular activities. However, a solid foundation in the sciences, along with a competitive GPA and GRE/MCAT score, are crucial for being a competitive applicant in the pool.
