



The Center for Advanced Emergency Care (CAEC) is accepting applications for CAEC Level 1, 2, and 3 certificate training programs. Topic areas include Clinical Toxicology, Emergency Department Administration, Prehospital and Disaster Care, Ultrasound, Pediatric Emergency Medicine, and Trauma.

CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY:

- Must be a practicing emergency medicine physician, advanced degree nurse*, or clinical pharmacist within a topic area of interest for practice improvement in their home country
- Eligible for US Visa
- Conversational English language skills or access to sustained interpretation services for the entirety of the program

*Advanced degree nurses not eligible for level 3 in clinical toxicology, but all other topics acceptable

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

LEVEL 1 & 2:

- CV
- Statement of interest surrounding involvement in topic area of interest in home country and plans following completion of Level 1 or 2 certificate program

LEVEL 3:

- CV
- Statement of interest which answers the following questions -
 1. What is your prior experience in topic area of interest?
 2. What do you hope to gain from completing additional training in topic area of interest?
 3. Describe your project proposal which you hope to complete during the Level 3 training.

- Letter of endorsement from employer which specifically mentions protected time for travel and project work
- Letter of financial support (if not covering tuition individually)

Level 3 applicants will be contacted to schedule an interview with program directors and key personnel.
