

## **Nanette K. Wenger Distinguished Service Award**

To recognize School of Medicine faculty who have demonstrated outstanding service and citizenship to the Department of Medicine. One award will be given in each of three faculty ranks:

- Assistant Professor
- Associate Professor
- Professor

Deadline: The deadline for all faculty awards nominations is **Monday, June 8, 2020**

Eligibility: All regular faculty (Assistant Professors, Associate Professors, and Professors) with a primary appointment in the Department of Medicine of Emory University are eligible unless they have received this award within the previous 3 years.

Nominations: All Faculty members must be nominated by another full-time or part-time faculty member, Division Director, or Service Chief. A concise, one-page narrative (5000 characters or less) describing the specific aspects of exemplary service to the School of Medicine and the Department of Medicine should be included in the nomination. Nomination for this award does not preclude nomination for other DOM awards in the same year.

Examples of outstanding service include:

- Service to house staff such as work in resident interviews, recruitment, and support
- Service to students such as program development for student support or sponsoring clerkships
- Service to patients
- Important administrative service to the Department despite heavy clinical and/or research demands
- Service to the community via public education programs or campaigns, volunteerism, or non-profit organizations
- Exemplary service to underserved populations
- Development of new or innovative programs that are recognized by the University or School of Medicine as representative of outstanding service by the Department of Medicine

Submission:

- One-page nominating letter (5000-characters or less)

Decision: Award nominations will be reviewed, and winners determined by the Department of Medicine Faculty Development Committee.

Award: The winner of this award will be announced during the “Celebration of Faculty Honors and Awards”.
