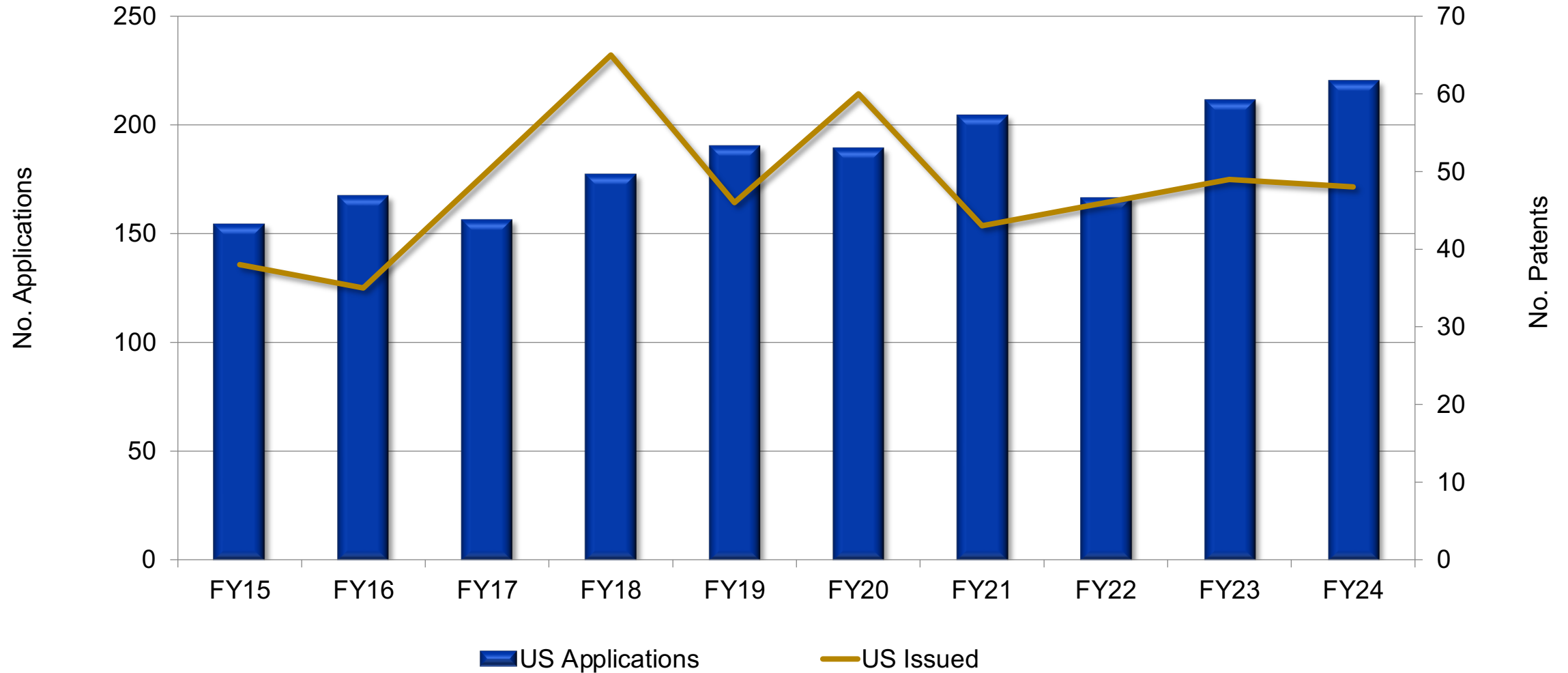

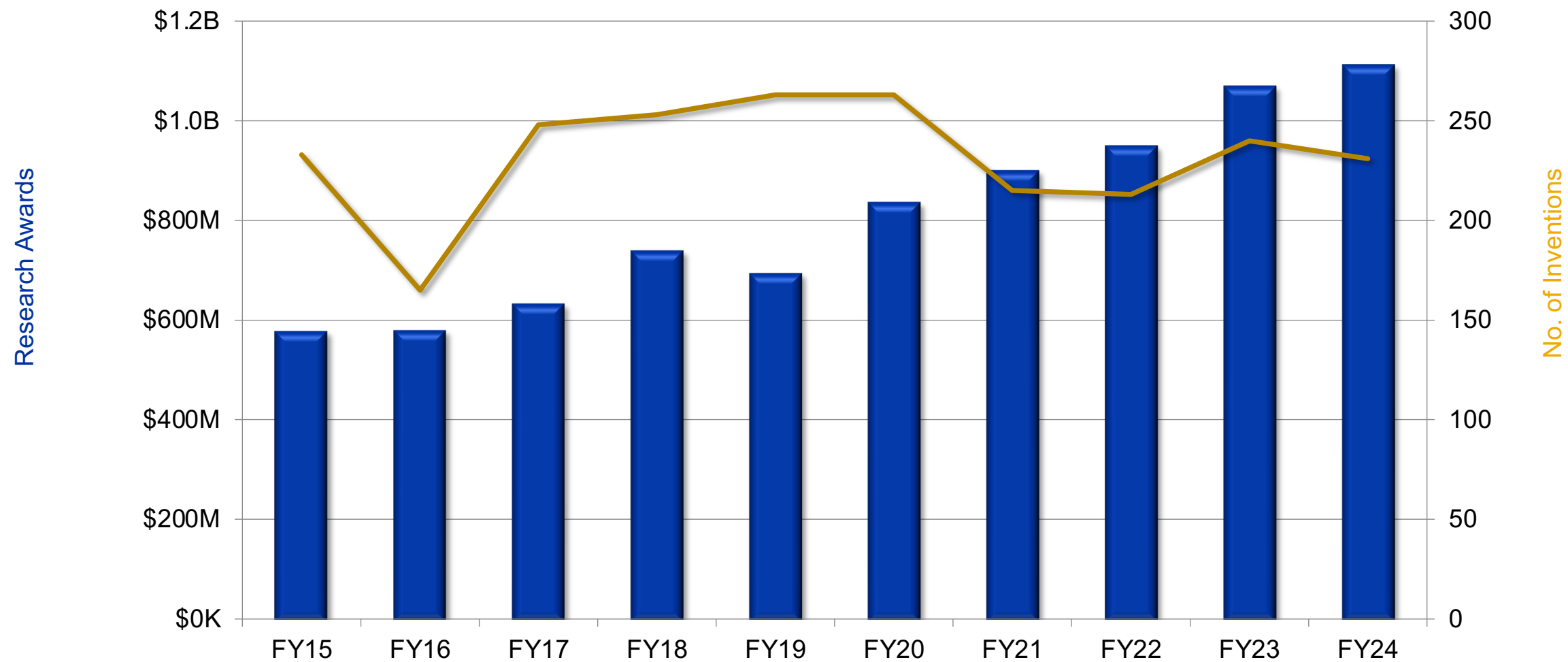

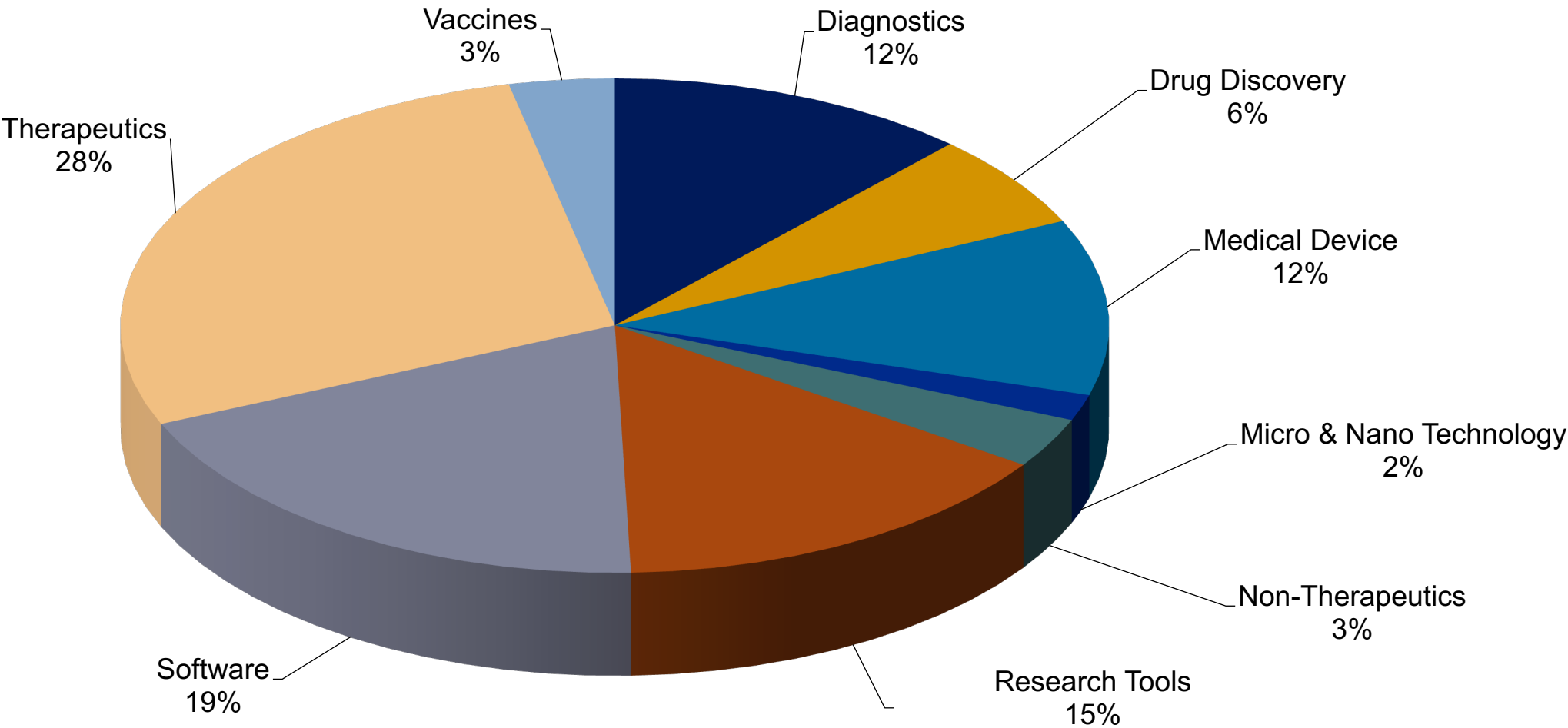
US Patent Applications Filed and Issued



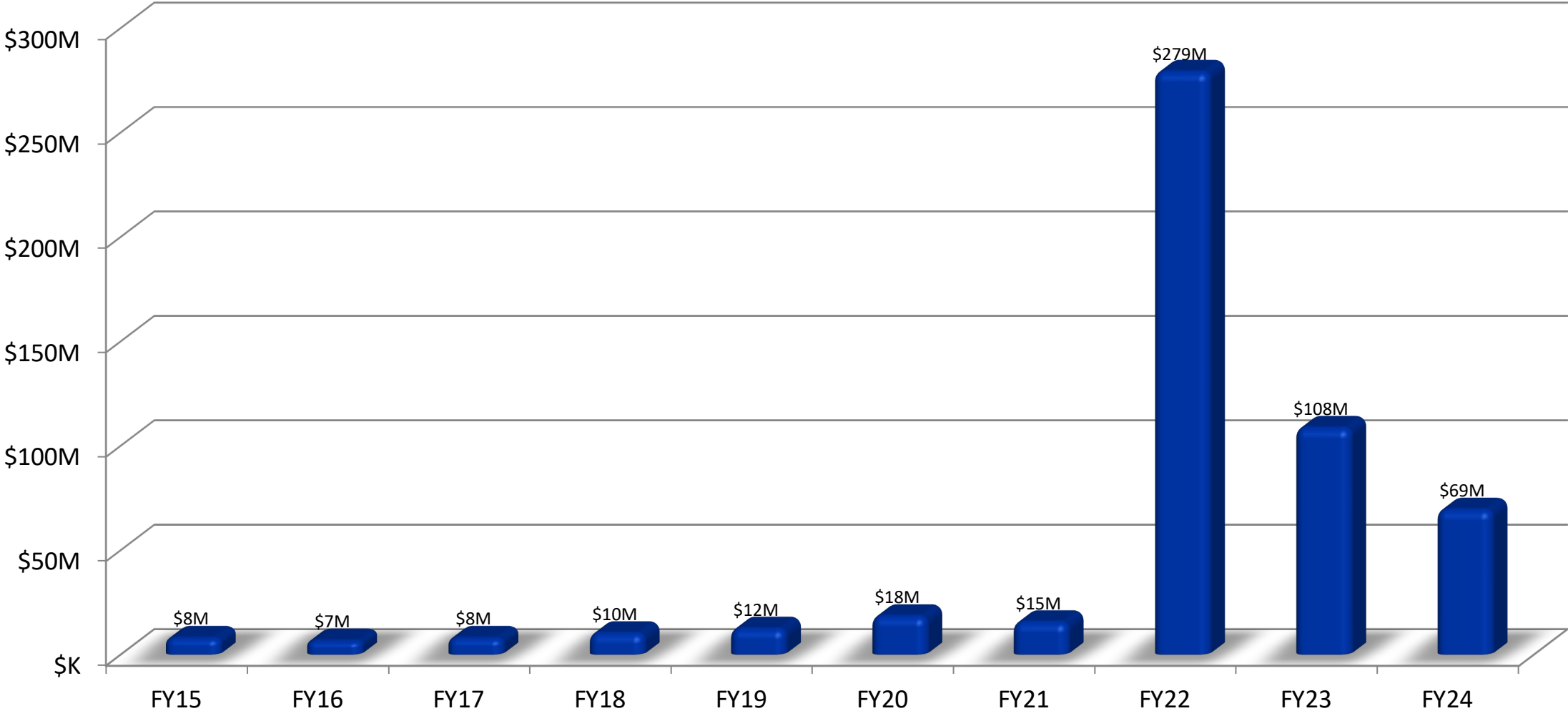
