DISCLAIMER

1. The purpose of the Minifellowship in Renal Ultrasonography is to give the attendee hands-on experience performing and interpreting sonographic studies of kidneys and urinary bladder. Other than the computerized teaching file, there is no formal didactic training. Although the course director or his designee will make every effort to assist the attendee when available and when necessary, this should not be assumed.
2. The Course Director (Dr. O'Neill) may or may not be present during all or part of week that you attend the Minifellowship and his presence should not be assumed. In his absence, another nephrologist fully trained in ultrasonography will be in charge.
3. The number of ultrasound studies performed by the Renal Service varies from week to week and is beyond our control. Although every effort will be made to ensure that the attendee performs an adequate number of studies, we cannot guarantee that there will be a sufficient number of studies to satisfy the 40 studies required to be performed for certification by the American Society of Diagnostic and Interventional Nephrology. As specified in the course description, the attendee will have two options (both free of charge) to complete the 40 studies.
4. The course tuition is nonrefundable unless a replacement can be found for the week that you are scheduled. There are no exceptions to this policy.
