Thank you to ALL our faculty and staff for their hard work during COVID-19. Let's celebrate the hard work you do each and every day!

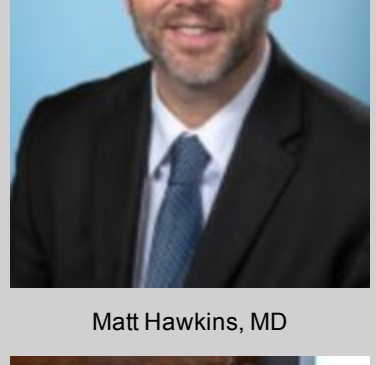
