


HeLP is a medical legal partnership (MLP) whose partners are Children's Healthcare of Atlanta, Georgia State University College of Law and Atlanta Legal Aid Society. A MLP provides the environment for healthcare professionals and lawyers to work together to help patients and their families with legal issues. HeLP is a free service to eligible families. You do not need a referral from a doctor, social worker, or hospital staff to reach out to HeLP.

Who Can Get HeLP?



- Child must be seen at Children's Healthcare of Atlanta or any affiliated institution
 - □ For example: Marcus Autism Center, Rehab, Urgent Care, Emergency Department, Children's Integrated Network
- Family must be ≤ 200% Federal Poverty Level; and
- Your legal problem is the kind that we handle.
