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## WHAT WE DO

### CONSULTING

Consultation may be provided to teachers and school staff to help guide classroom programming. Services may include but are not limited to observations, IEP review, and on-going coaching support.

### TRAININGS

Trainings are designed to be unique for the needs of a system or classroom and focus on topics including, but not limited to behavior programming and motivational resources, peer programming, teaching strategies, observation and consultation methods, and characteristics of autism spectrum disorder.

### PARENT SUPPORT

Parents can receive support through goal-planning meetings, trainings and guidance on improving skills for building school-home relationships.
