

## Daily Overview (April 2, 2020)

We continue with work to improve our internal processes and planning for the upcoming weeks.

---

### Safety:

- Governor Kemp announcement: State-wide shelter in place to extend through 4/13. In person schooling suspended for remainder of academic year.
- Procedure masks for the purpose of social distancing have been distributed to clinical site directors at the hospitals. These leaders are coordinating deployment to faculty, staff and trainees.

### Methods:

- Documents guiding the performance of portable imaging examinations and MRI for COVID+ vented patients have been finalized.
- Dashboard tracking PPE levels, staffing levels, and planning is in the works to add operational metrics of imaging volumes across sites.
- Ongoing work for surge planning.
- UV sterilization options are being developed for the purpose of reusing N95 masks.

### Equipment:

- Nearly complete deployment of Home Workstations.
- Developing plan to have portable US units in COVID+ ICUs/floors.

### Supplies:

- Emory currently has adequate supplies of PPE and cleaning supplies.

### Staffing:

- Divisions continue to fine-tune on- and off-site staffing to meet clinical needs.
- Outpatient imaging hours reduced to minimize need for contrast coverage.
- Pediatric Radiology has absorbed Scottish Rite into their practice, placing new burden on these colleagues.

- Because of shelter-in-place advisement and for access to health care facilities, always have your health care badge when traveling to and from work. 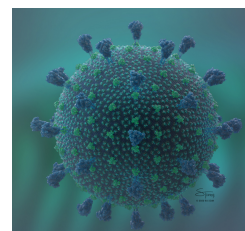
