

Daily Overview (April 14, 2020)

Volumes are holding steady as we continue to prepare for surge conditions related to COVID-19.

Safety:

- We are working closely with infection prevention and supply chain leadership around optimal protocols and supplies in the MRI environment.

Methods:

- Interventional Radiology has developed and extensively trialed detailed processes around virtual consultations and consents on inpatients, and will be expanding the processes across EHC sites and Grady in the coming week.
- Work continues on finalizing standardized system template modifications for Chest CT and Chest radiograph dictation templates.
- Expanded imaging workflow specialist (IWS) coverage at EUH (5p- 10pm on weekdays and 8a-8p on weekends) begins Wednesday, 4/15.

Equipment:

- Grady is planning for a peripheral hospital at the Georgia World Congress Center to support 200-400 beds for COVID patients.

Supplies:

- Supply levels are holding steady at sufficient levels. Please continue to follow recommendations for distributing and storing PPE.

Staffing:

- We have finalized a dashboard of EHC patient and imaging volume metrics to track for anticipated surge conditions, and are working on compiling similar Grady and CHOA metrics.

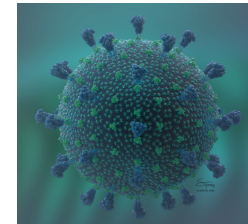
