Award Name	Call for Nominations	Description
<b>360 Faculty Award</b>	August annually	This award is bestowed upon a faculty member by the staff of the Department of Radiology and Imaging Sciences. It recognizes the outstanding dedication, professionalism, and collaborative spirit of an outstanding faculty member that works closely with staff and who embodies the values of mutual support, shared excellence, and patient-centered care.
<b>Rising Star Award</b>	August annually	To recognize Radiology and Imaging Sciences junior faculty (<7 years from completion of training) who demonstrate outstanding performance and promise in academic radiology.
<b>Faculty Inclusive Excellence</b>	August annually	This award recognizes a faculty member in the Department of Radiology and Imaging Sciences who demonstrates inclusive excellence to the benefit of the Emory community and/or the patients we serve and learners we teach.
<b>Outstanding Mentor</b>	August annually	This award honors a faculty member in the Department of Radiology and Imaging Sciences who has demonstrated exceptional commitment to the professional and academic development of trainees, junior faculty, and colleagues.
<b>Outstanding Clinical Radiologist JR</b>	August annually	This award recognizes Radiology and Imaging Sciences junior faculty (<7 years from completion of training) who consistently exemplify excellence in patient care, diagnostic acumen, professionalism, and collaborative practice.
<b>Outstanding Clinical Radiologist SR</b>	August annually	This award recognizes Radiology and Imaging Sciences senior faculty (more than 7 years from completion of training) who consistently exemplify excellence in patient care, diagnostic acumen, professionalism, and collaborative practice.
<b>Outstanding Clinical Research JR</b>	August annually	This award recognizes Radiology and Imaging Sciences junior faculty (7 years or less from completion of training) whose clinically focused research has significantly advanced patient care, diagnostic accuracy, and imaging practice.
<b>Outstanding Clinical Research SR</b>	August annually	This award recognizes Radiology and Imaging Sciences senior faculty (greater than 7 years from completion of training) whose clinically focused research has significantly advanced patient care, diagnostic accuracy, and imaging practice.
<b>Outstanding Scientific Research JR</b>	August annually	To recognize Radiology and Imaging Sciences junior faculty (<7 years from completion of training) who demonstrate excellence, innovation, and leadership in scientific research with measurable impact on the field.
<b>Outstanding Scientific Research SR</b>	August annually	To recognize Radiology and Imaging Sciences senior faculty (more than 7 years from completion of training) who demonstrate excellence, innovation, and leadership in scientific research with measurable impact on the field.
<b>Outstanding Service &amp; Patient Advocacy JR</b>	August annually	To recognize Radiology and Imaging Sciences junior faculty (<7 years from completion of training) who demonstrate outstanding clinical service, communication, and advocacy for patient-centered care.
<b>Outstanding Service &amp; Patient Advocacy SR</b>	August annually	To recognize Radiology and Imaging Sciences senior faculty (more than 7 years from completion of training) who demonstrate outstanding clinical service, communication, and advocacy for patient-centered care.
<b>Outstanding Service in Support of the Mission JR</b>	August annually	To recognize Radiology and Imaging Sciences junior faculty (<7 years from completion of training) who demonstrate exceptional dedication to the promotion of health, discovery and innovation, and educating the future healthcare workforce in line with Emory Department of Radiology's mission.
<b>Outstanding Service in Support of the Mission SR</b>	August annually	This award recognizes Radiology and Imaging Sciences senior faculty (more than 7 years from completion of training) who demonstrate exceptional dedication to the promotion of health, discovery and innovation, and educating the future healthcare workforce in line with Emory Department of Radiology's mission.
<b>Faculty Lifetime Achievement Award</b>	August annually	This is the highest award that the Department of Radiology and Imaging Sciences bestows on faculty who have made significant and sustained lifetime contributions in service, scholarship, leadership, teaching, and dedication to the patients and community we serve.
<b>Hidden Gem</b>	May/June annually	In 2015, the Emory Medicine Recognitions Committee instituted the Hidden Gem award. These faculty members have been nominated by their departments in recognition of their outstanding, but often unnoticed or unrecognized, contributions to Emory or beyond.
<b>Distinguished Service</b>	May/June annually	The award was established by the School of Medicine Recognitions Committee on behalf of the Dean to recognize faculty members who have demonstrated outstanding service and citizenship to the Emory community and/or Atlanta and surrounding region.
<b>Inclusive Excellence</b>	May/June annually	The Inclusive Excellence Award recognizes colleagues who promote a welcoming and supportive environment to benefit the Emory community.
<b>Innovation for Impact</b>	May/June annually	The award was established by the School of Medicine Recognitions Committee on behalf of the Dean to recognize faculty inventors, innovators, and entrepreneurs whose contributions resulted in a significant impact on human health or have the potential to be paradigm-shifting.
<b>Lifetime Service and Leadership</b>	May/June annually	The award was established by the School of Medicine Recognitions Committee on behalf of the Dean to recognize a faculty member's significant service to the School of Medicine through personal activities, influence, and leadership over the course of many years.
<b>Mentoring Award</b>	May/June annually	The award has been established by the School of Medicine Recognitions Committee on behalf of the Dean to recognize faculty who have demonstrated outstanding mentoring in the domains of education, service, and/or research to trainees or early career faculty during the past year.
<b>Scientific Integrity Award</b>	May/June annually	The award was established by the School of Medicine Recognitions Committee on behalf of the Dean to recognize faculty who have made significant contributions to the promotion of scientific integrity at Emory.
<b>Above and Beyond Award</b>	July annually	The Emory at Grady Above and Beyond Award recognizes a faculty member whose performance goes beyond the expectation of their position and advances the mission and vision of the School of Medicine.
<b>Advocacy Award</b>	July annually	The Emory at Grady Advocacy Award recognizes a faculty member's significant contribution in the field of advocacy. Advocacy is defined as seeking structural and policy change on behalf of patients, learners, and communities in ways that promote health equity, advance medical education, and/or improve patient care and outcomes.
<b>Best Colleague Award</b>	July annually	The Emory at Grady Best Colleague Award recognizes a faculty member who shows support of their colleagues and can always be counted on to be available to help their colleagues. This award recognizes devoted faculty who may receive fewer official recognitions and kudos than their colleagues, but whose contributions have truly made a difference and deserve acknowledgement.
<b>Career Impact Award</b>	July annually	The Emory at Grady Career Impact Award recognizes a faculty member whose dedication to the mission of Grady Health System has been evident over a long period of time.
<b>Community Impact Award</b>	July annually	The Emory at Grady Community Award recognizes faculty whose work has elevated our community at the level of our school, hospital system, or the city and counties that we serve. The award may honor an individual or team for various forms of engagement that have made a significant impact on the community that Grady serves or the members of Grady Health Care. This can include volunteer service, program development, or community organizing. Honorees should demonstrate a commitment to partnering with others to generate a sustainable impact on community needs.
<b>Innovation Award</b>	July annually	The Emory at Grady Innovation Award recognizes faculty whose innovation in research, education, service, quality, or leadership has made a major impact at Grady. This award identifies and recognizes faculty that have used creativity and innovation to improve patient care or trainee education by implementing new technology/ procedures, making significant scientific discoveries, creating new operational processes or pioneering new educational programs.
<b>Team-based Award</b>	July annually	The Emory at Grady Team-Based Award recognizes teams (of at least 3-4 members) of faculty and/or staff committed to a common purpose or goal toward advancing the mission and vision of the Emory School of Medicine.
