

Lactation Rooms for Employee Use



Below is a list of lactation rooms by campus. If you need to order a pump kit that is compatible with the breast pumps in the lactation rooms, contact Concierge at concierge@choa.org to request one at your campus.

Egleston campus

Conference Center, next to Classroom 11.

Tower 2, 2nd Floor: Two lactation rooms are outside the NICU Unit.

Tower 1, 4th Floor: Outside PICU Unit - one room is near the family waiting area.

Tower 1, 2nd Floor: Cardiac Step Down Unit - one room is near 2150.

Tower 1, 2nd Floor: Cardiac Intensive Care Unit: one room across from the Secretary's desk.

Scottish Rite campus

1st Floor: Inside the Radiology Department.

2nd Floor: Just outside the NICU entrance.

Marcus Autism Center

3rd Floor, Room 384. If the room needs disinfecting wipes or an employee needs a pump kit, contact the main reception desk.

The Office Park

1600 Tullie: Human Resources. See the receptionist at the front desk to get a key to the room.

1655-A: The room is located near the entrance and should only be locked when the room is occupied.

If a room needs disinfecting wipes, contact HR Reception Desk in Bldg. 1600, x57810. For after hours access to Building 1600, contact Security Services at The Park at x57711.

Hughes Spalding

The room is located in the Annex Building, Room. #32.3007 - across from the 3rd Floor Administrative Conference Room.

Park North

2nd Floor – The room is located near the break room. If the room needs disinfecting wipes or an employee needs a pump kit, contact HR Reception Desk in Bldg. 1600, x57810.

Park West

7th Floor – The lactation room is between conference rooms 5 and 6. For assistance, contact the see the receptionist at the front desk.

If a lactation room needs cleaning at Scottish Rite, Egleston or Hughes Spalding, contact EVS. For all other locations, contact Facilities. If a lactation pump needs to be inspected or services, contact Clinical Engineering.
