Track	Length	Max. Cohort Size	Time commitment/Activities
<b>Ethics</b>	12 months	12	6 two-hour, monthly sessions over the Fall and early Winter. 2-day Emory Healthcare Ethics conference in Spring; periodic, hour-long small group check-in sessions. Opportunities to participate in one of the Emory Healthcare or affiliated ethics committees. Participate in one or more teaching opportunities. Capstone presentation or project.
<b>GLOBE</b>	24 months+	20	Participate in asynchronous and in-person meetings. Participate in multidisciplinary team project production and presentation. Participate and successful completion of global/ local project.
<b>Health Equity, Advocacy, and Policy (HEAP)</b>	24 months	10	Independent learning [e.g., assigned reading, online modules]; Social Medicine elective [1-month, full-time course – available in Feb or March only]; Small Group Learning [Quarterly – format will vary; case-based learning, journal club, field trip, etc.] – Location and time will vary and may include evenings and/or weekends.
<b>Healthcare Management</b>	24 months	5	Residents will have a hospital site focus; residents will participate in evening and lunchtime lecture series; participate in a 12-day (or 2-day) quality improvement training series; Senior pathway members will participate in co-leading one of the case discussions in health policy and management
<b>Medical Education</b>	18 months	12	Small Group Learning sessions [Will typically occur online monthly, on a Wednesday from 4:00-6:00PM]; Intersessions activities [Typically 2 per phase, on a Wednesday from 4:00-6:00PM].
<b>Medical Innovation</b>	24 months	3	Participation in Coulter Program Series, Kaufman FastTrac course, Monthly seminar; Participation as a clinical mentor in the Biomedical Engineering Society Coulter College Program
<b>Quality Improvement &amp; Patient Safety</b>	24 months	10	Online learning [e.g., Basic Certificate in Quality and Safety (IHI) & Take the Lead on Healthcare Quality Improvement (Coursera)]; EHC Quality Academy Course: Leadership for Healthcare Improvement [2-day course - occurs Spring and Fall] ( <a href="https://med.emory.edu/vamc/quality-safety/quality-education-programs.html">https://med.emory.edu/vamc/quality-safety/quality-education-programs.html</a> ); Small Group Learning [Check points & Cohort Engagement – Every 2-3 months minus month of EHC Quality Course – format will vary: case based learning, journal club, etc.] – Will typically occur at 5:00pm at Emory's SOM Building.
<b>Simulation</b>	12 months	9	Small Group Discussions are held every month. Comparative analysis site visits to medical simulation centers. Hands-on simulation practicum comprising one-half day per week during one month. Participate in the design, facilitation, debriefing, and performance assessment.
