We continue to adjust staffing to changing clinical needs, and are coordinating across sites to best triage and prioritize patients.

Clinical Care:

- A coordinated team and approach across Emory sites has been formulated and will use best practices to reschedule outpatient imaging studies in conjunction with referring services.
- Patient diagnostic imaging time slots are being adjusted to facilitate necessary room cleaning protocols.
- Our IR, Nuclear Medicine, and Breast Imaging specific teams continue to work on prioritization and rescheduling of patients.

Clinical Staffing:


- Clinical divisions are monitoring imaging workloads and adjusting staffing accordingly.
- Radiologist Northern Arc Ad hoc outpatient moonlighting has been suspended until further notice in light of diminishing outpatient diagnostic imaging volumes.
- Radiologist moonlighting shifts are being assessed to determine need for additional or fewer shifts as clinical demand change.
- We are finalizing plans for specific allocation and deployment of 30 additional remote interpretation workstations for EHC.
- Information on IWS staffing and contact information has been sent via RadComm earlier today.
- Workforce management efforts for EHC staff are underway for telecommuting, redeployment, or reassignment based on organization needs during this event.

Education:

- Resident board review has been suspended in light of cancellation of the board exams.
- Resident noon conference is continuing on a faculty permissible basis.
